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Right to Join

The Trustees may only refuse an application for membership if, acting reasonably and properly, they consider it to be in the best interests of the Charity to refuse the application. In this unlikely case the Trustees shall inform the applicant in writing of the reasons for the refusal within twenty-one days of their decision. The Trustees shall consider any written representations the applicant may make about the decision. The Trustees' decision following any written representations shall be notified to the applicant in writing and shall be final.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) - Privacy Notice Summary

By signing this application form you are entering into a contract with Leicestershire & Rutland Bee Keeping Association for the provision of membership services. As part of the contract you will be providing us with personal data, which is protected by the GDPR. We will only process your personal data to run our organisation. Such usage will include, but is not limited to: (1) administration and management of the membership and business activities of the organisation, including making and keeping lists of members, arranging insurance and managing subscriptions; (2) communication by suitable means of newsletters, meeting notices, class notices and other relevant notices and requests regarding beekeeping activities; (3) producing name badges and signing-in sheets/books at meetings and classes; (4) sharing information regarding volunteers with the relevant organiser for a particular activity; (5) production and publication, by any means, of the annual report or any other publication; (6) assisting, for example, the National Bee Unit in the event of an outbreak of a notifiable disease or infestation relevant to bees and beekeeping within the region, including sharing contact details of members in order to protect the local honey bee population; (7) and any other activity that might reasonably be expected of a small member-based association of bee keepers relying on volunteers. We will not pass on or sell your details to any third parties for their own commercial use. We will hold and process your personal data under Lawful Bases:- Contract and Legitimate Interest. This means that we will not need your consent to hold and process your personal data and neither will we seek your consent. You have rights, including: the right to object to us processing your data; the right to instruct us to delete your data; and the right to instruct us to restrict the processing of your data. As we operate chiefly under Lawful Basis:- Contract, we will consider a request under your right to erase your data, restrict the processing of your data or object to the processing of your data as a request to also terminate your contract with the Association, for which there will be no refund of membership fees paid. You have the right to raise a formal complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office regarding what we do with your data, further information about which can be found at www.ico.org.uk.

Bee Stings and Allergic Reactions

Practical beekeeping unavoidably involves some risk of stings. While these are to most beekeepers no more than a passing nuisance, to a very small number of people they may pose a more serious risk, as described in the advisory leaflet L002 on stings prepared by the British Beekeepers Association (https://archive.bbka.org.uk/files/library/bee_stings-l002_1342858887.pdf) which you acknowledge you have read and understood.

By signing this application form you confirm that either you have never had to consult a doctor regarding an insect sting, or that if you have consulted a doctor they told you that you were not allergic to bee stings.

You understand that, as a condition of your membership, if you have been prescribed adrenalin (EpiPen or AnaPen) to be administered should you have an anaphylactic reaction to bee stings then you may not attend any live-bee event organised by L&RBKA.

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
